MIXED GAMES

- Different games may be combined to form mixed games. Games change either as a function of time or after a set number of hands.
- 2. Common mixed games include:

A. H.O.R.S.E.: Hold 'Em. Omaha/8, Razz, Stud, Stud/8

B. H.O.: Hold 'Em, Omaha/8

C. H.A.: Hold 'Em, Omaha

D. Eight Game Mix: Limit 2-7 Triple Draw, Limit Hold 'Em, Limit Omaha/8, Razz, Stud, Stud/8, No Limit Hold 'Em, Pot Limit Omaha.

E. Dealers Choice: A game where the player on the dealer button chooses the game (from a predefined selection) for that specific hand.

- When different games are combined into a mixed game there will be no Jackpot collection, as different jackpots cannot be combined.
- 4. When a mixed game is started there must be signage indicating.
 - A. What games are being played.
 - B. When the game changes and,
 - C. What the rake or collection will be and the method (time drop or rake).
- During play there must be a sign or tile stating what game is currently being played (that hand).
