ULTIMATE TEXAS HOLDEM

In Ultimate Texas Hold 'Em the player and the dealer receive two cards each and make their five card hands in combination with fivecommunity cards. The dealer qualifies with a pair or better. When the dealer does not qualify, your Ante wager is returned and all otherwagers receive action. The best five card hand wins.

To play against the dealer, the player must make an Ante and Blind wager. After viewing their cards, to continue play, the player must make a Play wager three to four times their ante, before anycommunity cards are revealed. Once the three card flop—the firstthree community cards— are exposed you may check or bet two timesyour Ante wager. After all community cards are exposed, if you havenot made a Play wager you may fold or make a Play wager equal to your Ante wager.

If your hand beats the dealer's your Play and Ante bets win even money. If you tie, those bets push.

RANKING OF HANDS Highest to lowest hands are as follows: Royal Flush, Straight Flush, Quads (Four-of-a-Kind), Full House, Flush, Straight, Three-of-a-Kind, Two Pair, Pair, and Highest Card.

BLIND BONUS A bonus is paid on the Blind if a player hits a straight or better and beats the dealer. If you beat the dealer and your hand is less than a straight, the Blind pushes. If you tie the dealer the Blind pushes.

TRIPS BONUS Bet on the Trips Bonus spot and win when you are dealt Three-of-a-Kind or better, regardless of the dealer's hand. You must place an Ante and Blind wager in order to play the Trips Bonus.

MAXIMUM PAYOUT The maximum aggregate payout per player during any one round, excluding the progressive jackpot payout is \$35,000.

Ultimate Texas Hold 'Em Progressive is an optional progressive bet. The bet considers the best hand possible among all the player's cards.
