Tulalip Resort Casino SERVICE ANIMAL POLICY

Tulalip Resort Casino gladly respects the need for Service Animals to assist qualified individuals.

We ask all guests of Tulalip Resort Casino to understand that we do NOT allow pets, and to kindly respect our service animal policy so that the occupancy and use privileges may be guaranteed for yourself, now and in the future.

Service animals are legally defined as "an animal that is trained for the purpose of assisting or accommodating a disabled person's sensory, mental, or physical disability." While we will not ask about the nature of a disability, legally we may ask about the service that is provided by said Service Animal. We likewise extend and establish our right to limit the number of Service Animals to ONE (1) per qualified disabled guest.

- Service Animals MUST be leashed or utilizing a service harness at all times within Tulalip Resort Casino or its grounds.
- Service Animals are NOT permitted in food preparation areas, but are allowed in dining and gaming areas provided they are not a nuisance to other guests and/or service animals.
- Owners must pick up and dispose of waste properly. Local regulations require waste to be double-bagged. A waste receptacle is available for that purpose to the right of the hotel main entrance and along the pedestrian trail within Quill Ceda Village.
- Service Animals should NEVER be left unattended to include hotel guest rooms, and/or vehicles.
- Service Animals must be on a flea prevention regimen to prevent any such spread.
- Accidents do happen. Please let the Front Desk know so that we can
 provide you with Nature's Wonder and cleaning towels. Please DO NOT
 use guest room linens to clean up any accidents as additional charges
 will be applied to the guest account if this occurs.
- A deposit is not required, however, a minimum Damage Fee of \$200 will be assessed if there is damage and/or excessive (not an accident) mess caused by a Service Animal while on property.
- Please note that we reserve the right to ask Service Animals be removed from the property if noisy, clearly untrained for their service role, or inappropriate Service Animal behavior is a disturbance or detrimental to other quests.
