Musical legends and icons for over five decades, The Commodores bring their special blend of Motown R&B, funk and pop to the Orca Ballroom audience. With more than 70 million albums sold, including seven #1 hits, The Commodores continue to influence artists young and old, and in all genres, with their classic songs such as "Brick House" and "Three Times a Lady."

Skid Row (Saturday, Oct. 30; tickets on sale Sept. 3, \$60/\$50)

It all began in 1986 with New Jersey Kids pulling together with punk and metal attitude. The result: top 10 singles including "Youth Gone Wild" and "Piece of Me," gold and multi-platinum record sales, and #1 on the Billboard album chart. Prepare for a great show spotlighting their self-described "rambunctious exuberance" brand of us-against-them rock.

Grand Funk Railroad (Saturday, Nov. 13; tickets on sale Sept. 17, \$60/\$50)

From the 1970s onward, Grand Funk Railroad has been part of the soundtrack of many music lovers' lives. Evolving from its original garage-band based rock and roll roots to a more rhythm and blues/pop rock-oriented style, the band has produced multiple major hits, including ""I'm Your Captain (Closer to Home)," "We're An American Band" and "Some Kind of Wonderful."
