



BRETT YOUNG, DAUGHTRY AND KOOL & THE GANG WITH THE AVERAGE WHITE BAND HEAT UP THE TULALIP AMPHITHEATRE STAGE IN AUGUST WITH THREE CONCERTS UNDER THE STARS

TULALIP, Wash. - Rock band Daughtry is fronted by namesake Chris Daughtry, who first achieved stardom during the fifth season of "American Idol." The band has been rocking audiences nonstop since 2007 and is known for its stellar showmanship. Daughtry routinely attracts sell-out crowds and has sold more than 9 million albums and 25 million digital tracks in the U.S.
- With 70 million albums sold worldwide, music industry legends Kool & The Gang have influenced the music of three generations thanks to R&B classics "Celebration," "Cherish," "Jungle Boogie," "Summer Madness," "Open Sesame" and others. Known for their signature funk and jazzy arrangements, the band has earned two Grammy Awards, seven American Music Awards, 25 Top Ten R&B hits, nine Top Ten Pop hits and 31 gold and platinum albums.

Concertgoers can expect more R&B classics as the Average White Band performs a string of hits including the million-selling instrumental "Pick Up the Pieces," selections from popular albums *AWB* and *Cut the Cake* and more.
